







William Dalrymple Maclagan was prominent in the Church of England having served in five positions in London before becoming Bishop of Lichfield and finally Archbishop of York

from 1891 to 1908. Donald Maclagan is his third cousin. A prominent churchman, William Maclagan was also a talented church musician and wrote 9 hymns and 30 tunes; all of these are gathered here in a single volume for the first time. The hymns are complete and the tunes are in the Archbishop's own 4-part harmony.



The Hymn Tunes of William H. Devlin






