#### ORGANIST/WORSHIP TEAM LEADER JOB DESCRIPTION

#### **Main Roles and Responsibilities**

- (1) Take a lead role in providing music at our main Sunday services at 11am, and our twice monthly 9.30am services (excluding July and August), and at such other services as the Kirk Session may require, including Easter and Christmas. You will not be obliged to play on weekdays at times which interfere with your main weekday employment.
- (2) Work closely with the Minister/Worship Team to develop the use of music and musical gifts within the life of the congregation by means, for example, of developing our existing Praise Band and also by increasing the sung repertoire of the Congregation.
- (3) Play (subject to your attendance not interfering with your weekday employment) at wedding and funeral services and all other services not specified in paragraph (1) if requested by the line manager and be paid the proper fee by those who engage you. The fee shall be £80 for weddings and £65 for funerals, payable by the wedding couple/the family of the deceased as appropriate and shall be reviewed annually. You will also be entitled to charge an additional fee of 50% in respect of wedding services recorded by audio and 100% in respect of wedding services recorded by audio/visual means. This fee does not apply to our regular services specified in paragraph (1) and shall also be reviewed annually. You may waive your right to play at such services and shall not then be entitled to this fee.
- (4) You will carry out such additional duties as may reasonably be requested from time to time.

The organ shall normally be reserved for your personal use, and also for the use of a recognised assistant or deputy.

A small budget will be set aside annually for the purchase of music and other necessary items.
